(b) What is the 21st century world's attitude toward this sin?

3. (a) How does Paul describe ungodly speech in Ephesians 5:4?

(b) In what ways does ungodly speech reveal a callousness towards sin?

(c) Does this mean that Christians can't joke? What distinguishes between foolish talking and humor?

4. (a) What is the root sin of coveting, according to Ephesians 5:5?

(b) Give a biblical example where the sin of coveting led a person into deeper sin.

5. (a) What is the method for Christians to deal with these sins, according to the following verses?

Romans 6:5-6

Romans 6:11-12

Colossians 3:5

(b) Put this teaching into your own words. How do you daily obey this teaching?

6. (a) What warnings does Paul give to Christians in Ephesians 5:5-6?

(b) What are examples of “empty words” that could deceive Christians? See also Ephesians 4:14-15, and 29.

7. (a) What does perpetual sexual sin and greed reveal about a person, according to Ephesians 5:5?

(b) How can we walk in love (5:2) in the world among unbelievers and yet keep ourselves separated from the behavior of the world (5:7)?

8. Review what God has done for us in Christ to deliver us from the condemnation of sin in Ephesians 1-4. Pick some phrases from these chapters that are particularly meaningful to pray for unbelievers in your life.
