1. (a) Why did the multitude follow Jesus into Capernaum?

(b) What did Jesus exhort them to seek instead?

2. (a) How did the people think they could please God, according to their question in verse 28?

(b) What was Jesus' response?

3. What signs had the people already seen that made their request in verse 30 unnecessary? (See also Matthew 14:35-36)

(b) What were the blessings and the limitations of manna? (John 6:49, Exodus 16:14-21, and Numbers 11:4-9)

4. (a) List the verses in John 6:22-71 where Jesus refers to Himself as bread. What do you learn about the True Bread in each verse?

(b) What benefits await those who take the true bread which He offers?

5. (a) What does it mean to come to Jesus (verse 35)? (See also Matthew 5:6, 11:28-30)

(b) Who are those who will come to Him (verses 37, 44, 45, and 65)?

(c) Does this mean there is no human responsibility? Why or why not?

6. (a) Describe the progression of unbelief in the multitude in verses 41-42, 52, 60, and 66.

(b) How do you relate this to present-day situations where people walk away from the life that Jesus Christ offers?

7. (a) What had the twelve disciples seen and learned about Jesus that the multitude had not?

(b) What was Peter's response to others walking away?

(c) What is your response when you don't understand a "hard saying" from God's Word?

8. Meditate on the picture of Jesus Christ as the true Bread from heaven. In what ways has He been living Bread to you personally?
